



ST. LOUIS RAMS STADIUM SURVEY

ST. LOUIS MEDIA MARKET

Survey conducted January 26 – January 27, 2015. 776 likely voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2016 General Election. Margin of Error is +/- 3.4%. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding. Survey conducted by Remington Research Group on behalf of Missouri Alliance for Freedom.

Q: If you had to choose one, what is your favorite professional sports team in St. Louis?

St. Louis Cardinals.....75%
St. Louis Rams.....12%
St. Louis Blues.....13%

Q: How would you feel if the St. Louis Rams relocated to Los Angeles?

Very disappointed.....36%
Somewhat disappointed.....26%
Not disappointed.....17%
Not disappointed at all.....22%

Q: How important do you believe the St. Louis Rams are to the area's economy?

Very important.....36%
Somewhat important.....42%
Not important.....14%
Not important at all.....7%

Q: Do you believe the St. Louis Rams need a new stadium?

Yes.....31%
No.....69%

Q: Do you believe subsidizing professional sports teams' stadiums with tax dollars is a good idea or bad idea?

Good idea.....15%
Bad idea.....70%
Don't know.....15%
